For performing services for update of the Technical scope as part of the public procurement documentation for award of detailed design – phase working project, supply of equipment, construction, service staff training and commissioning of gas interconnector Greece – Bulgaria.

DEAR MR. HARPS,

In view of the fact that "RAP Systems" OOD is an entity that prepared the Technical scope as part of the public procurement documentation for award of detailed design – phase working project, supply of equipment, construction, service staff training and commissioning of gas interconnector Greece – Bulgaria and pursuant to art. 191, par.1, item 2 PPA, we are addressing an invitation to you for performing services related to update of the Technical scope and submission of the supplementary information as listed below in that invitation.

1. Contracting Entity.

Contracting entity of this public procurement are the representatives of ICGB AD - a company, pursuant to art.5, par. 4, item 1 PPA.

2. Subject of the public procurement:

Performing services for update of the Technical scope as part of the public procurement documentation for award of detailed design – phase working project, supply of equipment, construction, service staff training and commissioning of gas interconnector Greece – Bulgaria.

3. Estimated value

The estimated value of the public procurement is up to BGN 20 000 VAT excluded.

4. Legal grounds

This procurement is awarded pursuant to art. 191, par. 1, item 2 PPA - through an invitation to particular persons.

Grounds: The person invited by the Contracting Authority to submit an offer is the author of the Technical Scope as part of the tender documentation for award of detailed design – phase working project, supply of equipment, construction, service staff training and commissioning of gas interconnector Greece – Bulgaria in accordance with Contract as of 15.08.2016 concluded with the invited. As a result of the execution of the contract, a Technical Scope was prepared, but additional documents such as the Hydraulic Report, the Design Basis Memorandum, the SCADA Report were also elaborated afterwards and therefore it is required that the Technical Scope is updated.

The prepared Technical Scope is subject to copyright under Art. 3, para 1, item 1 of the Copyright and Related Rights Act (CRRA). Any modification and updating of the Technical Scope by a person other than the one who elaborated the original document conflicts with the provision of Art. 18, para. 1 of the CRRA, according to which the author has the exclusive right to use the work he has created and to authorize his use by other persons, for use in the meaning of para. 1 determines the processing and synchronization of the work. Recasting is also the adaptation and introduction of any kind of changes to the work, i.e. its updating or upgrade in the sense of Art. 18, para. 2, item 8 of the CRRA.

In this sense, the services that need to be performed in addition to the updating of the Technical Scope include actions for updating, agreeing, approving, possibly correcting and can only be performed by the person who prepared it.

5. General information.

At the beginning of 2016 investment planning of both sections of the Site (Bulgarian and Greek) was practically completed for the purposes of permitting construction and the Project has obtained for the Bulgarian section Construction Permit No48 dated 12.09.2017 published in the State Gazette No76/2017.



EU grant financing up to EUR 45 million under European Energy Program for Recovery (EEPR) has been extended until 2018. The recommendation of EC to Bulgarian and Greek authorities has been considered to investigate the options for additional grant financing of the Project through access to funds under European structural funds (ESIF in both countries. As of today, the process for being included into the ESIF financed program is launched.

The IGB project has the status of a Project of Common interest under Regulation 347/2013 and it is a main priority project under the CESEC initiative for gas interconnectivity in Central and Southern Europe. In this context, the European Investment Bank and other international credit institutions have expressed active interest in financing the Project, including through instruments from the new European Fund for Strategic Investments (EFSI).

The Bulgarian government in turn has included in the state budget for 2018 access to an increased amount of state financial guarantee when negotiating loan facilities for the project of up to EUR 110 million.

According to the current schedule for realization of the Project, the construction is expected to be commenced at the end of first half of 2018 and the public procurements for selection of Line Pipe Supplier and for Owner Engineer have already been started.

6. Scope of services.

This procurement comprises performance of the following services:

- Update of the Technical scope for award of detailed design phase working project, supply of equipment, construction, service staff training and commissioning of gas interconnector Greece – Bulgaria based on analysis of the new version of the Design Basis Memorandum;
- 2. Update of the Technical scope for award of detailed design phase working project, supply of equipment, construction, service staff training and commissioning of gas interconnector Greece Bulgaria based on the Report for hydraulic investigation of IGB project showing possible scenarios for gas transportation in Greece-Bulgaria direction alongside with new amendments of hydraulic calculations based on the requirements of update of hydraulic study prepared for IGB Project.
- 3. Update of the Technical scope for award of detailed design phase working project, supply of equipment, construction, service staff training and commissioning of gas interconnector Greece Bulgaria based on SCADA report aiming at analyzing the sequence and establishment of differences of the Technical project and the documentation for engineering Front End Engineering Design (FEED) developed for Bulgarian and Greek territory for gas interconnector Greece Bulgaria. The analysis and the update must comprise all documents related to the documents for the



Integrated automated system for control and management system of IGB pipe line (SCADA).

7. Implementation term

The total implementation term **is 20 days** as of the date of submission of the additional documents required for performing of the services as the Hydraulic Report, the Design Basis Memorandum, the SCADA Report by virtue of hand-over delivery protocol signed between the Parties.

8. Term of validity of the offer

The offer shall have a validity term of 60 calendar days as of the date it is submitted to the Contracting entity.

9. Deadline for submitting the offer

The offer along with the appendices shall have to be submitted by 23.02.2018, 18:00 in the premises of ICGB AD, Sofia, 13 Veslets Street, floor 2.

10. Requirements to the contents of the offer

The offer and the appendices to it shall be submitted as per the samples attached herein. The offer and the appendices to it shall be submitted in Bulgarian and in English language.

The offer shall be submitted as a hard copy and shall contain:

- A list of the documents;
- An offer containing a technical and a price offer;
- 2 Declarations under art. 97, par. 5 PPA;

The declaration for non-existence of circumstances under art. 54, par. 1, item 1, 2and 7 PPA shall be signed by the persons representing the applicant. When the applicant is represented by more than one person, the declaration for the circumstances under art. 54, par. 1, item 3-5 PPA shall be signed by the person that can represent it individually.

The price offered shall have to include a total lump sum for performing the service, all costs included, as well as prices for each of the activities separately.

The offer shall be submitted personally, through an authorized person or by courier, at the office of the Contracting entity.



11. Considering the offer. Concluding a contract.

The offer of the applicant invited shall be considered in accordance with the requirements of the Rulebook for application of PPA.

Before concluding the contract the applicant invited shall have to submit documents evidencing the non-existence of the circumstances under art. 54, par. 1, item 1-5 PPA, namely:

- A conviction certificate of the person representing the applicant invited;
- A certificate by the revenue authorities and by the municipality as per the seat of the contracting entity and the applicant invited for non-existence of liabilities for taxes and mandatory social security contributions pursuant to art. 162, par. 2, item 1 TIPC and interest on them to the state or to the municipality as per the seat of the Contracting entity and the applicant invited.
